BRANTFORD POLICE SERVICES BOARD POLICY #01-01

Re: Investigative Supports

It is the policy of the Brantford Police Services Board with respect to investigative supports that the Chief of Police will:

- a) establish procedures and processes in respect of investigative supports, including, at a minimum:
 - i) scenes of crime analysis;
 - ii) forensic identification;
 - iii) canine tracking;
 - iv) technical collision investigation and reconstruction;
 - v) breath analysis;
 - vi) physical surveillance;
 - vii) electronic interception;
 - viii) video and photographic surveillance;
 - ix) polygraph, and
 - x) behavioural science.
- b) establish procedures and processes in respect of obtaining, when required, expert or specialized assistance from another police service, government agency, other organization or individual, in relation to a criminal investigation being undertaken by the police service.
