Deputy Chief Nelson highlighted crime trends over the past five years. Offences which are trending upwards included sexual offences, robbery and break and enter of businesses. He indicated that sexual offences had increased over 2012 and were above the five-year average, but noted that a number of offences had occurred in one month by one person. He was pleased that thefts from autos had decreased, as well as theft of motor vehicles. He spoke on the effectiveness of Team Shutdown, a joint forces operation into auto thefts. He noted that the 2013 total for motor vehicle accidents was below the five-year average. He provided the top ten locations of accidents in the City, and was asked to provide this data to the City Engineering Department.
