

Brantford Police Services Board

Policy #06-07 – Adequacy Standard Underwater Search and Recovery Units

Description

It is the policy of the Brantford Police Services Board with respect to the services of an underwater search and recovery unit that:

- a) this Board will contract with the Ontario Provincial Police to provide the services of an underwater search and recovery unit and major incident commander, available 24 hours a day, within a reasonable response time.
- b) the Chief of Police, in consultation with the service provider, will:
- establish procedures that set out the circumstances in which the underwater search and recovery unit will be deployed, including the process for obtaining the services and the reporting relationships;
- II. establish procedures for the deployment of other emergency response services, including receiving assistance from other agencies.
