Governance – Board Member Obligations

Description

Purpose

1. Board members collectively receive, question and assess reports from the Brantford Police Services and others, to collectively make decisions intended to ensure that policing actions and results in City of Brantford are congruent with Community needs, values and expectations.

Requirements

Board members are obligated, by virtue of their appointments and oaths, to:

1. Uphold and abide by the laws, regulations, bylaws, policies and decisions of the Board.
2. Comply with the Code of Conduct Policy, Conflict of Interest Policy and Procedural Bylaws.
3. Actively participate in Board orientation and police governance education and training opportunities.
4. Actively prepare for and contribute to the fulfillment of Board's job description (refer to Policy 24-04).
5. Refrain from engaging in activities or communications that pre-empt, obstruct or otherwise draw Board attention away from fulfillment of the Board's job description.
6. Refrain from using any Board or Service resources including facilities, equipment, supplies, services or any resource that belongs to or is funded by the Board, for election campaign or any campaign-related purposes. (refer to Policy 18-01).
