Policy #01-01 Investigative Supports

Description

It is the policy of the Brantford Police Services Board with respect to investigative supports that the Chief of Police will:

1. establish procedures and processes in respect of investigative supports, including, at a minimum:
 - a) scenes of crime analysis;
 - b) forensic identification;
 - c) canine tracking;
 - d) technical collision investigation and reconstruction;
 - e) breath analysis;
 - f) physical surveillance;
 - g) electronic interception;
 - h) video and photographic surveillance;
 - i) polygraph, and
 - j) behavioural science.
2. establish procedures and processes in respect of obtaining, when required, expert or specialized assistance from another police service, government agency, other organization or individual, in relation to a criminal investigation being undertaken by the police service.
