

## Policy #24-15 Misconduct and Discipline

## **Description**

It is the policy of the Brantford Police Services Board to act in compliance with the Community Safety and Policing Act and its Regulations as it relates to misconduct and discipline.

- 1. The chief of police shall establish procedures for the proper handling of allegations of misconduct.
- 2. The chief of police shall establish procedures for the discipline of a member of the police service who has been found to have committed misconduct or unsatisfactory work performance.
- 3. The chief of police shall report, in accordance with the regulations, to the police service board, the aggregate disciplinary measures the chief has taken under the Act.

Publication and forwarding of reports

- 4. The board shall.
- a) publish the reports on the Internet in accordance with the regulations made by the Minister, if any.
